# ETIQUETTE

## (Unwritten Rules)

The rules of golf are well documented and precise; however there are “unwritten rules” which govern behaviour on the course. These are designed to increase the enjoyment of all and are based on courtesy and consideration for others on the course.

Be ready to play at your starting time.

Announce which ball you are playing.

Do not damage the tee with practice swings. Watch the balls in flight to avoid wasting time in searching.

Do not drive when players are chipping or putting on an adjacent green.

Do not “cut in” unless there is a full hole behind.

Move smartly between shots and be ready to play your shot in turn. Leave your clubs on the route from the green to the next tee.

Replace divots, repair pitch marks, rake bunkers.

Remember that conversation and sudden noise are distracting. Avoid disturbing others that are playing shots.

Five minutes are allowed to search for a ball. This does not mean that you may hold up those behind you for five minutes. If the ball is not immediately found, and if the hole ahead is clear, allow those behind you to play through.

In Stableford or Par competitions, it is recommended that you pick up when either zero points or a loss of hole has been recorded on a hole.

Obey the Course Rangers at all times.

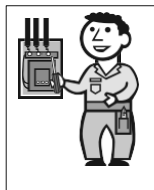

# PACE OF PLAY

## R&A Guidelines

We all have differing views on what constitutes acceptable and unacceptable pace of play, but the fact is that slow play detracts from the enjoyment of the game for many players. Few golfers are heard to complain about play being too quick! There is a responsibility therefore, on all players to ensure that golf is played at a good pace and a pace appropriate to the course being played.

## How players can minimise round times:

- Be aware of your position with regard to the group in front and keep up with that group.
- If you feel that your group is losing ground, tell the other players in your group.
- If your group is behind, try to catch up.
- If you lose a clear hole and are delaying the group behind, or if there is no group in front of you and you are delaying the group behind, invite the group behind to play through.
- Be ready to play your shot. While exercising due considerations for other players in your group, put your glove on, check your yardage, pick your club and line up your putt while others are playing.
- At the green, speed up your exit by positioning your bags on the way to the next tee.
- Move off the green as soon as all players in your group have holed out and mark score cards at or on the way to the next tee.
- Play a provisional ball if your ball may be lost outside a hazard or out of bounds.

You can all help to speed up play by adopting “Ready Golf” in all games other than match play

## **ON THE TEE**

No “Honour” – the first player on the tee plays first

## **FROM TEE TO GREEN**

All golfers should go to their own ball.

When you reach your ball and the course is clear .... Play!  
(even if your playing partners have not reached their ball)

When waiting to play, decide on your shot, select your club,  
and be ready to play when it is your turn.

## **LOST BALLS**

Players should help to look for a lost ball, only after they have found and played their own ball. If the ball is not found within 5 mins., it is considered lost.

(If there is a chance your ball may be lost, play a provisional ball just in case)

## **ON THE GREEN**

Leave bags, buggies & trolleys on the exit side of the green  
Survey your shot whilst others are putting, so that you are ready to putt when it is your turn. First player to have holed out picks up the flag.

## **MARK YOUR CARDS AFTER LEAVING THE GREEN**

Adopt these principles, and the game will speed up and be more enjoyable.

**All Casual golf is to be played from the yellow tees.**

**Whites are for Competition Use Only.**

## Winter Rules – Preferred Lies – Lift, Clean & Place

It's a **local rule** only and is also known as '**winter rules**'. It's only in effect if you're **informed upon arrival** at the golf course. '**Preferred lies**' means a golfer can lift up the ball (if he or she wants to) that is landed on a closely-mown area and move it to a position (placed not dropped) within six inches (the length of the scorecard) in any direction, but not nearer the hole.

In a preferred lies situation you **always mark** your ball first (with a tee, ball marker, or pitch reparer). A closely-mown area is any area of the course that is cut to **fairway** height or less and includes **paths cut through the rough** and the **fringe/apron** around the green.

If the player fails to mark the position of the ball before lifting it or moves the ball in any other manner, such as rolling it with a club or foot, it's a breach of Local Rule, and incurs a penalty of **two strokes** in Stroke Play, **loss of hole** in Match Play
