- > Archiving is ongoing.
- If there are no changes to any topics from the Main Committee rather than keep saying ongoing I will just report when an issue has been resolved.
- Shoe Cleaner Work in hand to improve the area around the cleaner.
- Junior fees Although the junior fees were reduced the number of Juniors has not increased. Andrew will be asked (he was not present) to look at fees again.
- SGU development officers are meeting with Andrew and Jill Byrne.
- Printer cabinet will be made to house the printer and lap top. This was completed this week.
- > Outdoor shelter will be erected for players to place their bags in when it rains.
- Correspondence has been received from the EGU regarding the use of nonqualifying scores to supply information regarding members' results.
- Management proposed to set up a Winter SSS for use by new members. This proposal was rejected by the Handicap Committee.
- > Juniors had their first meeting of players and parents on 7th January.
- Dave Gregory expressed concern about the cost of the food for the Presentation evening. It was agreed that the Captains would get together to discuss the issue.
- > The rough behind the 15^{th} Green will be left to grow longer to prevent balls running on to the 16^{th} tee.
- > The outside of the Main Building will be painted this year.
- From March 1st Buggies allowed on a day to day basis.
- Course Clocks are to be repaired and will only be placed on the course during the playing season.

4. Lady Captain's Report

The Mail on Sunday is not being organised this year due to the difficulties some clubs have at the beginning of the season with course conditions. They are reviewing the situation for next year.

A reminder of what was said at the A.G.M. - as it was so long ago. Wheathill has a bye in the Rogers Cup and the Centenary Plate. The first match for Wheathill in the Rogers Cup is at Cannington versus Mendip, and in the Centenary Plate it is at Minehead against Enmore.

With help from Ann, Sue and Melanie the handbook has been updated and is on the website.

There followed some discussion regarding the competitions requiring 3 qualifying cards. The list was amended and the revised copy will be sent to the Pro-shop.

5. Lady Vice-Captain's Report

I have already been very busy working on friendly matches for 2017 season. We have fixtures arranged for;

I attended a meeting at Long Sutton Golf club on Sunday 20th November 2016 with Christine Burrows from Cricket St Thomas and Sandra Basford from Long Sutton.

The meeting was an informal discussion on the rules pertaining to the Trimatch. Sandra Basford and Christine Burrows had more knowledge of the history behind this competition and shared it with me. Jointly we agreed the following points to be adhered to for the matches in 2017. The Captains for 2018 may discuss and make changes to this as they see fit.

- We will keep with the 6 highest scores out of 8 to be counted.
- Each team can include a maximum of 3 silver players, there is no minimum stipulation of silver players. 8 bronze players can be selected.
- The handicap will be 90% for all players.
- The 3 team captains on the day will go out in the first group to enable them to receive players' cards as they finish the round. All subsequent matches will go out in handicap order.
- The match order is rotated each year. 2017 order of play will be Cricket St Thomas, Wheathill, Long Sutton. 2018 order of play will be Wheathill, Long Sutton, Cricket St Thomas.
- The trophy will be presented at the last match to the winners. If you hold the trophy don't forget to bring it with you!
- Abandonment of match. In extreme weather conditions the captains can agree to abandon the match. If 9 holes or less have been played the fixture can be re-arranged at a mutually convenient date. If more than 9 holes have been played the scores for all teams will stand.

It was emphasised that this is a friendly competition aimed at introducing new ladies to interclub play and that overtly competitive behaviour and language has been witnessed in the past not in keeping with this ethos.

On Wednesday 28th June, we have the bag of beans against the seniors. Sign-up sheets for all these fixtures will be posted in the locker room 6 weeks beforehand.

The mixed open is on Sunday 16th July, entry forms are available on the mixed noticeboard at the club and the golf empire website.

We have a Lady Captain's away day to Tall Pines on Thursday 27th July and in lieu of a second away day Sue and myself wish to encourage as many ladies as possible to join us for the Cricket St Thomas Rally on Monday 17th July. At £17 each for a round of golf with light lunch and the chance of a prize it represents great value for money.

25 ladies have paid deposits for the away weekend to St Pierre, Chepstow on 10th and 11th September. If anyone else is interested in coming I may be able to secure additional rooms. I will also keep a reserve list in case anyone should drop out before the event.
