Autumn Course Renovations will be happening on the week of 13th September. This is going to consist of scarifying, coring, top dressing and over seeding. Then the greens will be fed with fertiliser to help boost recovery. These are essential treatments to improve the aeration, combat compaction, promote healthy growth and help prevent disease. We are looking into a larger primary mover (tractor unit) and mobile deck system for a rough and fairway back up. This would take some strain off of the fairway and rough mowers, especially during the time of year when the course becomes a grass factory!

On Tuesday 14th September, the main room in the Clubhouse will be closed in the morning for inside seating.
