## **Captains Day Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> July**

The competition was fully subscribed with 80 entries and A Francis N Harris G Westlake and M Joyner formed the winning team, A total of £1657 was raised of which after expenses and the purchase of a compressor leaves £1157 for the completion of a new cleaning area, which it is hoped will commence construction in September. Any resulting surplus will be allocated to the Air Ambulance fund.

The committee felt that there should be no limit on the number of times and consequently the number of prizes awarded in any week, conversely any member may lose as much as they want on a once daily basis.

As a consequence the **Lydford Cup and Trophy** would be restructured , Top 2 from each division in medal week competitions running from September 2022 to July 2023, would be invited to play in the one off cup event in August. The person with the best net average over the three best scores submitted during the competition period would be awarded the trophy.
